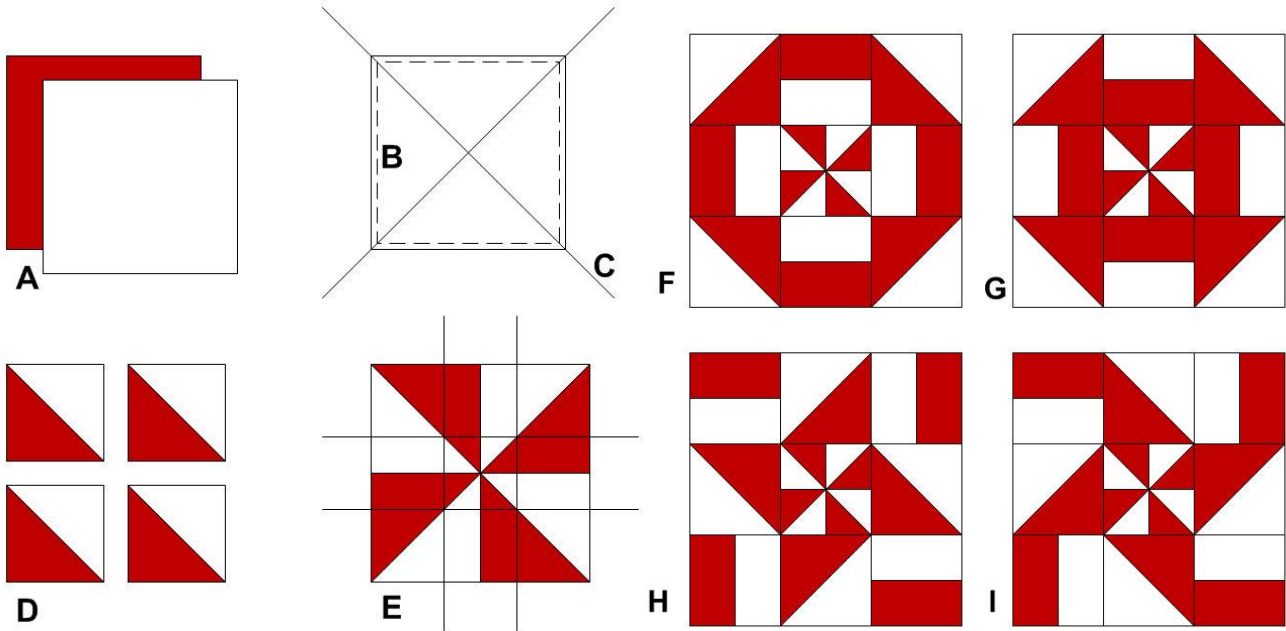
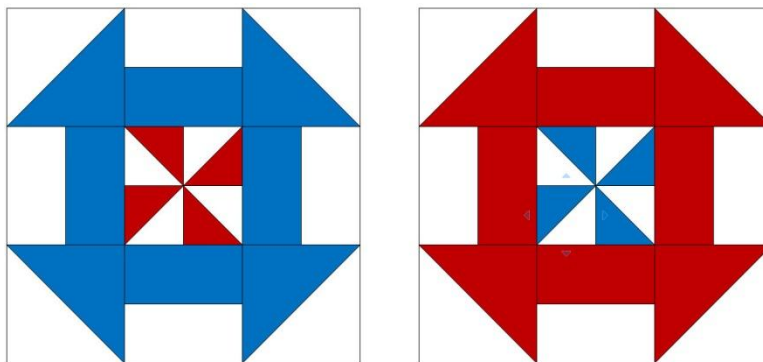


DISAPPEARING PINWHEEL



1. Pick 2 contrasting colors (layer cake is perfect for this or cut 10" squares);
2. Lay right sides together (see A);
3. Sew 1/4" seam all around (closing the block) (see B);
4. Cut from corner to corner twice (see C);
5. You will end up with 4 HST (see D);
6. Press your HST and sew into pin wheel (see E);
7. Measure your block; if "weird" size that is hard to divide by 3 cut your block down to size that can easily be divided, for example from 10" layer cake blocks you will end up with approximately 12 3/4" to 13" block depending on your seam accuracy; cut it to $12" / 3 = 4"$ cuts; cut on solid line (see E);
8. Now the fun begins: you can twist and turn blocks as seen above (see F = shoo fly; G = churn dash; H = friendship star / Illinois road; I = whirligig) OR switching colors between blocks for patriotic or scrappy look (see below).
