Here is the info about the grocery bag from Iris:

1. It is super fun to make....
2. Takes max 30 minutes (for first time maker) (depends on how fast one sews of course) but when quilts may take weeks this is fun idea that might take just minutes to finish.
3. Is partially lined ...
4. Only takes 1 yard ... if non directional ... if directional need like yard and $\frac{1}{4}$ to be safe though you can squeeze it out of 1 yard as well .
5. Fun way to use up fabric you either don't know what to make out of it ... or perhaps fabric that you consider a bit "ugly" but no ugly enough to throw away.
6. It's about the same size as Walmart bag.
7. The way it's made (French seams and some other stuff) super strong.
8. Fun idea for gift bags (birthday or Christmas) or rather than buying reusable bag making your own.

This does require a pattern piece ... if you wish I can prepare it on special cardstock so in case you would like to make more than one bag it will last longer. Cost would be buck a pattern.
