### Bock Bock Bucket

- A Chicken Bucket was passed out in December 2025 and January 2026 and you are to label it and add two yards of fabric into the bucket.
- You will swap buckets each month and make at least one 12-1/2' block (or many) out of the fabric in someone else's bucket. You may add additional fabric from your stash and we want you to put your skills to work. Paper piece, traditional piece, appliqué and use all your talents and make these blocks for someone else in the guild. You will get one credit for each different 12-1/2 block you make. Each pattern must be different from others in the bucket. Variety is the spice of life!
